SLAPBOX

for accordion and 2-channel fixed audio

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Performance Notes

The performer should use a stopwatch synchronized with the start of the fixed audio part. Long tones on accordion should be held for duration of line extending from starting pitch. Extended Techniques

- Air Sounds (0:06) Use air release valve to create air/wind sounds. Volume and intensity are represented by size of air sound graphic.
- Bellow Slaps (0:30) Use right-hand to slap between bellows, producing a flapping sound.
- Rolling Tap (0:43) With accordion bellows slightly expanded, tap across the front of the accordion from bass switches to register keys (left to right) or register keys to bass switches (right to left) with flattened right-hand, rotating at the wrist.
- Clusters (2:00) Groupings of notes performed with palm of hand on keyboard or bass keys.
- Circular motion on bass keys (3:04) With right-hand knuckles, rub bass keys in a circular motion.
- Bass switch taps (3:30) Tap rhythm on bass switches with both hands.
